



Good news on the TreatNow front. For the 1st time, the U.S. Senate has passed and moved legislation to the House of Representatives that calls for the VA to use Hyperbaric Oxygenation. Senators Hoeven and Cramer (ND) sponsored the Bill urging the VA to "enter into partnerships with non-federal government entities to provide Hyperbaric Oxygen treatment to veterans to research the effectiveness of such therapy". This legislation comes as the VA pilot demonstration project on the use of Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBOT) for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) has shown near total success at five sites across the U.S. The TreatNow Coalition has been working for over a decade to see such legislation enacted. Our Detachment has been helping since 2016. It is now up to the House of Representatives to make this legislation a reality. For the full text of the Bill, google Senate Bill, S.785. The Commander John Scott Hannon Veterans Mental Health Care Improvement Act of 2019, is a Bill to improve mental health care provided by the Dept. of Veterans Affairs and for other purposes. Title VII, Section 702 provide details.

TreatNow has added a blog to their website. The blog provides up to date information about the treatment of PTSD and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). It is well worth a look. Google TreatNow.org and click the blog button.

Corps History

1 August 1960

The Corps' Enlisted Rank & Pay Structure Board revised existing rank structure by incorporating the rank of Lance Corporal and the E-8 and E-9 Pay grades.

2 August 1950

1st Marine Provisional Brigade lands at Pusan, South Korea.

3 August 1950

Eight Corsairs of VMF-214 the famed 'Black Sheep squadron of World War II, executed the first Marine aviation mission in the Korean War in a raid against enemy installations near Inchon.

6 August 1847

Marines commenced their march on the "Halls of Montezuma" in Mexico.

7 August 1990

President Bush ordered U.S. military aircraft and troops to Saudi Arabia as part of a multi-national force. One week later the Marine Corps announced the commitment of 45,000 troops to Operation Desert Shield – largest deployment of U.S. forces since Vietnam.

13 August 1918

Opha Mae Johnson became the first female Marine when she enlisted in the Marine Corps Reserve.

14 August 1945

President Truman announced Japan's unconditional surrender.

17 August 1942

2nd Marine Raider Bn under Lt. Colonel Evans F. Carlson landed on Makin Island and destroyed a seaplane base, two radio stations, a supply warehouse, and killed about 100 Japanese troops.

19 August 1919

Marines Hymn Registered with the U.S. Copyright Office.
