

1942

2 December

Carlson's Raiders neared the end of an epic 26 day patrol on Guadalcanal.

1943

26 December

1st Marine Division lands on Cape Gloucester, New Britain.

1947

1 December

The Corps' first helicopter squadron, HMX-1, was commissioned at Quantico, VA.

15 December

The Secretary of the Navy signed a Memoran-dum of Agreement' with the State Department which laid the basis for the modern Marine Se-curity Guard program at U.S. Embassies through-out the world.

1950

1 December

The 1st Marine Division began its bitter with-drawal from Yudamni, North Korea.

4 December

Lt. Colonel Raymond G. Davis led the 1st Bat-taion, 7th Marines into Hagaru-Ri, Korea after four days of intense fighting in the mountain passes against a numerically superior hostile-force, clearing the way for the 5th and 7th Marines. Lt. Colonel Davis was awarded the Medal of Honor for his heroism.

24 December

Last elements of the 1st Marine Division depart-ed Hungnam, North Korea.

1965

20 December

Operation Harvest Moon ended for Task Force Delta (2/7, 3/3, and 2/1). More than 400 Viet Cong were killed in action.
