

### Welcome to the 2021 Event

In 1982 at the first Gloucester 24 hour track race the world record was set. The distance still stands as the current British record of 170 miles 974 yards (274.480 kms) set by Gloucester club member Dave Dowdle.

In 1984 the first Gloucester 48 hour race was held where Dave completed 384.050 km. The current British record holder is Richard Brown with a distance of 401.207km set in France in 1991. This year Richard is running in the 48 hour event alongside his wife Sandra, who is the W55 British record holder with 327.526km.




