# One-Day Pilgrimage to The Shrine of the Grotto of the Redemption in West Bend **Many Seats Available!!**

We are sponsoring a one-day pilgrimage to The Shrine of the Grotto of the Redemption in West Bend, Iowa on Saturday, October 11, 2025. The Grotto has been designated as a pilgrimage site for this Jubilee Year of Hope. So, if you missed the bus pilgrimage to Wisconsin in June or just want to see the Grotto and receive more graces, consider joining us in October. Our itinerary is confirmed with the Grotto and Grotto Rector, Monsignor Ed Girres, as is our transportation. (Roberta Peters, Regent)

As was done with the Wisconsin Pilgrimage, our bus will pick us up from the St. Pius X Church parking lot in the morning and we will return that evening. Since we will be traveling in October, we hope it will allow us to see the Fall colors.

Our expenses include transportation, lunch, and the full afternoon program at the Grotto that day. We are looking at a total cost of \$120 per person. Unlike the previous trip, our driver's tip is included in the cost. Registration will be available soon. If you know NOW that you will be attending, please let me know! #### **National Convention Fundraiser:**

As the host state for the **2026 National Convention**, State CDA has set a fundraising goal of \$30,000 for the event budget. Each court is asked to contribute \$500 to State CDA by December 1, 2025, so that the budget can be finalized and preparations can move forward.

Immediate Past State Regent Suzanne Torrey has suggested free-will bake sales ("Bake Across Iowa"), but we are considering a Pecan Sale. Genuine Georgia pecans sold well this summer and are available year-round. Sales would run in October and November, with pickup at the Bazaar inside St. Pius X Parish Hall - bringing more visitors to the event. We will vote on the fundraiser at the September meeting.

Hello CDA Sisters of Court #1768.


This month we are shining the spotlight on Anne Reynolds.
