

Seed Resurrection

by Frank Wesley, 1923-2002

Frank Wesley was born in Azamgarh, Uttar Pradesh into a fifth generation Christian family of Hindu and Muslim descent. He belongs to the Lucknow school of painting. His paintings reflect this influence and that of the Chughtai school of painting that flourished in India at the turn of the century. Wesley made art based on both biblical and secular themes. "My main work," said Wesley, "is to paint the Bible in our own Indian way. It is to do something for the church in the field of art." He used watercolors, oil paintings, miniatures and wooden carvings. He is also known for designing the funeral urn for Mahatma Gandhi's ashes.
