Creation of Light by John Martin, 1824 Cleveland Museum of Art

The first in a series of biblical illustrations by John Martin, this print presents us with the dawn of creation. In this image, the inscription cites Genesis 1:2–3 and so refers to the creation of light itself on the first day. Nevertheless, the work encapsulates all of the first four days of Creation: light, firmament, dry land, and lights in the heavens are depicted together here. Martin may simply have wanted to depict several aspects of God's work of Creation, but his decision to depict several episodes simultaneously might also reflect the difficulty of depicting the first appearance of light as a stand-alone subject.


*We would like to provide an opportunity for those of you who are interested to participate in worship leadership. Following are the opportunities available.
