

PER CAPITA: THERE WAS AN ERROR IN INFORMING MEMBERS OF THE AMOUNT FOR 2026 PER CAPITA. **2026 PER CAPITA is \$40.66**, NOT \$39.24 AS WAS PREVIOUSLY STATED.

Through January and February, AUPC encourages you to pay your per capita. Part of a member's responsibility is to pay their per capita yearly. We encourage the first two months so that two-month total may be deducted from the total AUPC is responsible for to pay the Kiskiminetas Presbytery. This year, based on prior year membership, AUPC is required to pay Presbytery \$4,187.98. We are permitted to make monthly payments, therefore, when the amount we collect in January and February is deducted from the above total due, that gives us a new balance which is divided by the 10 remaining months, hopefully giving AUPC a smaller monthly payment that does not increase the stress on the General Fund.

Please be aware that AUPC is responsible for the entire amount whether a member pays their fair share or not. January and February are suggested as per capita payment months for the reasons listed above. However, we accept per capita all year long.
