Basketball Coach's Corner – Jan. 7, 2025 - Madison



LOOKING BACKWARD IN AHS BASKETBALL 117TH YEAR

The 2024-2025 Season is the 117th year of Ashland basketball. The Orange and Black squads have won 1310 games and have lost 935 times. The AHS quintets won the Northern Central Ohio League 11 times, the Cardinal Conference 10 times, the Ohio Heartland Conference twice, and the Ohio Cardinal Conference twice. This will be the 17th year in the OCC. In tournament play they have won the Sectional or District 23 times, and four times they have advanced in State. In 1932,1936,1937, and 1941 the state tournament was the Sweet 16. The entire history is located on the website: www.centuryarrowsbkb.com.

2019-2020 - The Arrows, without two injured starters, won Sectional title for the 17th time in school's history. However; the high point of the season was two wins over Mansfield Senior in four days. The 29-point margin (67-38) at Arrow Arena was the largest Ashland blowout in the 225-game series.

The leading scorers for the Arrows were: Co-MVPs and OCC First-Teamers Mitch Heilman (433 pts.-65 three's) and Luke Denbow (18.2 ppg in 18 games). Second-Team OCC Eli White scored 328 points. Freshman, Grayson Steury, dropped in 197 points. Brandon Utt received the George Valentine Sportsmanship award.

2004-2005 - In his final season at Ashland, Coach Chris Stokes took his team to the Sectional finals for the sixth time in seven years. Freshman Taylor Housewright inspired a 1:39 six-point comeback to gain an overtime win over Marion Harding when he fed Anthony Bell for the winning basket. It gave the A's the chance to face the eighth ranked Mansfield with 19-consecutive wins in the finals. It was the Tygers again for the 23rd tournament ending time for Ashland. The team's MVP, Anthony Bell, led in scoring (410 pts), rebounds (136), and shooting (FGs 52% and FTs 73%). Dan Hess set the school record with 68 three's for the season and 123 for his career topping Chad Honaker's. Scott Heimann had 82 assists. Coach Stokes, whose teams had won one OHC, the Sectional and District twice, and a record of 96-62 (.608), moved to his third head-coaching job, as the mentor of the OCC rivals the Wooster Generals.

1994-1995 - The A's played against three state tournament teams (Zanesville, Orrville, and Clyde) and beat a 20th ranked Mount Vernon, but the classic win was at Lexington for the first-ever OHC win against them. Jeff Honaker again was the leading scorer (339 points) and First Team OHC was Co-MVP with Craig Starkey, who was the top rebounder (145) and field goal shooter (62%), plus steals (32). Karl Singleton was the best defensive player for the second year and Matt Timmons was Mr. Hustle again. Jake Stickney had the best free throw percentage (84%). Jeff Gierhart led in three-pointers (25) and assists (111). Jeff Honaker moved into the top 20 on the all-time AHS scoring list. The three Honakers (father Dave and sons Chad and Jeff) moved into second-place on the all-time "family" scoring register with 2448 points behind the four Messner brothers (Dick, Bob, Max, and Jim) with 2625 points.

1984-1985 - Phil Hawk came back to Ashland after coaching at Mansfield St. Peters. The three Mapleton transfers led the team in scoring: MVP Bruce Fagert (255), Chuck Ritchey (225), and Darrell Crall (203). The tri-captains were: Crall, Albert McKinney (118 pts), and Scott Van Scoy (78 pts). The Arrows with only one conference win, upset the CC champs, the Madison Rams, in the Sectional opener on Scott Shilling's tremendous 26-point evening (and 199 pts for the season). The A's almost beat Mansfield in the Sectional finals, a team that went on to the State finals. This was the only Orange and Black cage team to win a tournament game from 1979 to 1989.

1964-1965 - With one letterman and no senior starters the Arrows could only tie for last in the Cardinal Conference but they did win four of the last seven games. Again, Mansfield ended the tournament trail. Junior letterman Rosey Robinson led the team in scoring with 341 points. But he was just Second Team All-CC. Tom Roberts led the A's in rebounds with 178 boards. Rosey received the Times Gazette MVP award at the banquet and Dick Messner, Grace College AD and coach, who still held the AHS career record back in 1948, was the banquet speaker.

1954-1955 - New coach George Valentine's team came together at the end of the season winning five straight games. The biggest win was the upset of undefeated and nineth ranked Shelby in the Sectional tournament. Three big men inside led the team: Max Messner (315 pts), center Dick Rankin (289 pts), and Tom Enck (268 pts). The guards were Jim Runyon (222 pts) and Dave Brubaker (163 pts). The season again came to the end with the third loss of the season to Mansfield.

1939-1940 - All-NCO forward, Vince Barr, set two scoring records. He broke the NCO record with 163 points and Ray Miller's AHS mark with 260 points for the season. Captain Barr's supporting cast was: Dean Duffey (113 pts), Second Team NCO Bob Howell (103 pts), Honorable Mention NCO Bob Atterholt (97 pts), and center Tom Bear (56 pts). The A's biggest wins for Coach Longley in his third and final season were Mansfield and Marion, which knocked the Prexies out of first place.

1914-1915 - It was the year that AHS had no basketball teams. However, a new high school was under construction on Cottage Street with a new gym on the basement floor next to Fourth Street. It has historically been referred to as the "Girls' Gym." Meanwhile the YMCA continued their four-team City League for high school boys. The potential high school team played as an independent team called the "Tigers." They played a schedule against area opponents from Polk, Lodi, Shreve, and Wooster. The lineup was: Harold Stockwell (12th), Russell Sonners (12th), Clarence Miller (10th), Don Smith (11th), and Henry. The subs were: Marshall Mohn, Wayne McDowell, and Paul Dessenberg.

COACHES BIOS

Head Varsity Coach-Jason Hess - This is Coach Hess' tenth year as the Ashland Head Varsity Coach. Prior to this, Coach Hess was Varsity Assistant for six years and served as the JV coach for four years all at Ashland. He also graduated from Ashland High School in 2000. As an Arrow, he was a three-year letter winner and three-time MVP. Jason played college basketball at Malone College and led the NAIA Division II nationally in rebounding his senior season. He became the second all-time leading rebounder in school history and an NAIA All-American. Jason graduated from Malone College in 2004 with a joint degree in business administration and accounting. Coach Hess currently lives in Ashland with his wife Jen and their daughters, Sydney and Dublyn. He continues to farm with his father, Steve.

Varsity Assistant Coach-Scott Sauder - This is Coach Sauder's fourth year coaching basketball at Ashland High School. He has been a teacher and football coach in the district for the last 20 years. He is currently also the Middle School Athletic Director. Scott is a 2003 Graduate of Ashland University where he earned four varsity letters as part of the Eagles' football team. Coach Sauder currently lives in Ashland with his wife Tiffany and their children, Tyler, Aliviah, and Teagan.

Varsity Assistant/JV Coach-Keith Vipperman - Coach Vipperman has been coaching for 42 years. He is currently in his fourteenth season with the Arrow Hoops program. He spent twenty years as JV and Assistant Varsity Coach at Crestview and two years at Crestview as Head Coach. After Crestview, Coach Vipperman went onto Willard to serve as Freshman/Varsity Assistant Coach. He is a graduate of Crestview High School and works for Pepperidge Farm. Keith is married to Michelle, who is the Administrative Assistant in the AHS athletic office. They have two children Danielle (Brody) and Brett (Maddie). They also have one grandchild and are expecting another one in May.

Freshman Coach-Stiles O'Brien - This is Coach O'Brien's first year as Ashland's freshman boys' basketball coach. The past three years, he has coached at Ashland Middle School. O'Brien coached football at Ontario High School in the 2022 and 2023 seasons; however, this past season he joined Ashland Arrows football staff. Coach O'Brien is a Lincoln High School grad (Ellwood City, Pa). He also attended Youngstown State University where he played football. Stiles moved to Ashland in 2010 and around 2014 he started to help youth athletes with speed and agility training. He is employed by Ashland City Schools. O'Brien currently lives in Ashland with his wife Jenny (Ashland grad, 2001) and their daughter Kyla and son Killian.
