# PORTISHEAD AUTOMATIC RADIO TELEX INTERIM PROCEDURE

## **Before calling**

Have the number of the party you wish to call ready. For international calls, you will need to use the 'Country Code'. Then you can follow the procedures for your terminal unit.

#### Channels

From-ship automatic facilities are available on those channels emitting a free signal (mixture of A1 A and F1B) telex answer-back 3220 AUTO G. Manual services will continue on channels emitting A1A (DE call sign) signal. Telex answer-back 46116 BTGKA G.

- **Notes:** a) xx is the country destination code preceded by a zero. yy is the called party's telex number. End the telex number with a + sign.
  - b) send only one message per command code.
  - c) to-ship traffic may be collected, when already using an automatic channel, with command code DIRTLX46424+
  - d) store and forward facilities are available on manual channels.
  - e) operator assistance is available on manual channels.
