

Oceans of speed and efficiency – new from BTI

- BTI's unique 'Frequency Watch' facility, will enable the ship to input its data 24 hours a day in the Portishead computer.
- The store-and-forward service that ensures any message sent out of 'office hours' is automatically received on the telex machine by the time the receiving office opens.
- Advice of non-delivery.

High frequency

The new service operates through the vital international maritime communications link of Portishead Radio Station – so telexes can fly between you and your ships to and from most parts of the world.

Direct ship-to-shore dialling to the UK and most other countries is fully automatic, without the need for manual assistance.

Shore-to-ship connections can also be made automatically if a ship inputs its watchkeeping data into the computer at Portishead.

Even if details are not logged in this way, Portishead can still transmit your telex when the ship makes contact.
