
Lunch Suggestions

TIPS & HIDDEN GEMS

- Dublin is best explored on foot or by taxi/public transport with limited parking and busy traffic in the city centre. There are 2 options I recommend:
 - o An express bus runs directly from Mitchelstown to Dublin (3 hrs)
 - My favourite route is driving to nearby Thurles train station, parking the car and taking the train into Dublin Heuston station (1hr 15 mins). From there it's only a 15-min walk or 5-min taxi to Guiness Storehouse
