Instructions on Circulating Nomination Signatures for Jonathan Brostoff

Thank you so much for agreeing to circulate nomination papers for Jonathan Brostoff to help get him on the ballot for Milwaukee Common Council. By law, our campaign needs to collect between 200 and 400 signatures for Jonathan to appear on the ballot. However, we are working to collect over 600 signatures, to demonstrate Jonathan's strong support within the 3rd Aldermanic District!

Here are some important instructions and points to keep in mind when circulating nomination papers:

- Signers must be “qualified electors” and reside within the boundaries of the 3rd Aldermanic District.
- **Residents do not need to be registered to vote to sign nomination papers.** Anyone who is 18 years or older, a U.S. Citizen, has lived in the 3rd District for at least 28 days, and has not lost the right to vote due to a criminal felony conviction for which the person is currently on probation, parole, or extended supervision is a “qualified elector” and may sign nomination papers.
- As a circulator, **you must personally witness each signature.** Nomination papers cannot be left unattended while gathering signatures.
- **Please do not sign or date the bottom of the nomination papers until after you have finished collecting signatures.**
- Please double-check that all names and addresses are legible and that none of the fields have been skipped or left empty. **Signatures may not be counted by the Milwaukee Election Commission if fields are inaccurate or incomplete.**
- Make sure to **sign and date** the bottom of all nomination papers you collect before returning them to the campaign.
- Campaign staff will number the bottom right corner of all nomination papers. **Please do not enter any page numbers.**
- Gather as many eligible signatures as you wish! **You do not need to fill out all ten spaces per page.**

You may gather signatures by going door to door, circulating them at appropriate events, or on public property. **If you're on private property, you must gain the property owners' permission before gathering signatures there.**

We request that nomination papers be submitted back to us by **May 25th** in order to allow appropriate time to process the forms before submitting them to the Milwaukee Election Commission.
