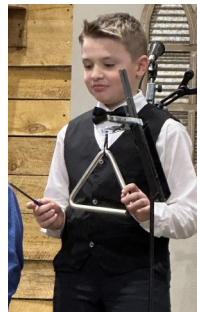
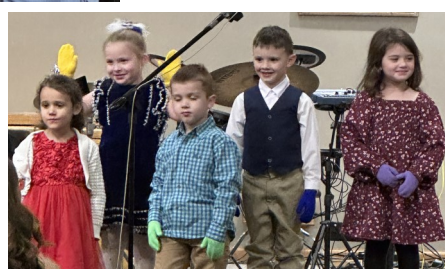
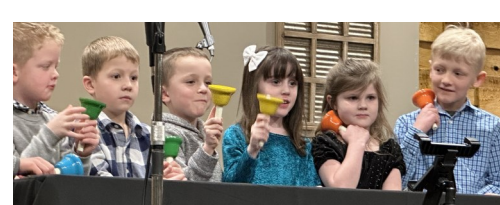

Leading scorer for the Bulldogs was Kara #10 who put up 32 points for her team.

HS Boys Basketball Has a Homecoming Win!

The Patriots won an exciting homecoming matchup on Thursday, January 30 against the Traverse City Bulldogs (TCBAA), 63-50. Senior Sebastian Vrieze and sophomore Sam Bigger attacked the basket on back-to-back positions, giving the Patriots a quick 4-0 lead. The Patriots moved the ball well, working inside out, and getting a lot of quick, easy layups inside.

They led 18-11 at the end of the first.

The Bulldogs went on a run to start the second, regaining the lead at 23-22 through some hot three point shooting. However, the Patriots ended strong to close out the half, taking a 29-26 lead heading into the locker room.

It was all Patriots in the third, with Sam Bigger and Sebastian Vrieze leading the charge. They created a number of turnovers that led to some quick fast break opportunities. The Patriots led 48-38 at the end of three.

The Patriots added to the lead to start the fourth, with senior Noah Vogler knocking down a big triple. The Bulldogs continued to fight hard, incorporating a press that led to a couple baskets, but the Patriots passed the ball well and forced the Bulldogs to foul them. Sophomore Lucas Husted entered the game and went 4-4 from the free throw line, helping to clinch the Patriot victory.

Sophomore Sam Bigger led all scorers with 23 points, 5 rebounds, and 5 assists. Senior Sebastian Vrieze added 12 points, 3 assists, and 4 steals. Senior Wyatt Beebe got his first start of the season, and scored 4 points in the win.

The Patriots also secured a 55-22 win on the road at Crossroads Charter Academy on Monday, February 3. The wins improved the Patriots to 9-2 on the season. The Patriots will be back home on Thursday, February 6, when they host Central Michigan Homeschool at 7:00 p.m.
