2026 Robotics Team Students & Volunteers Needed!

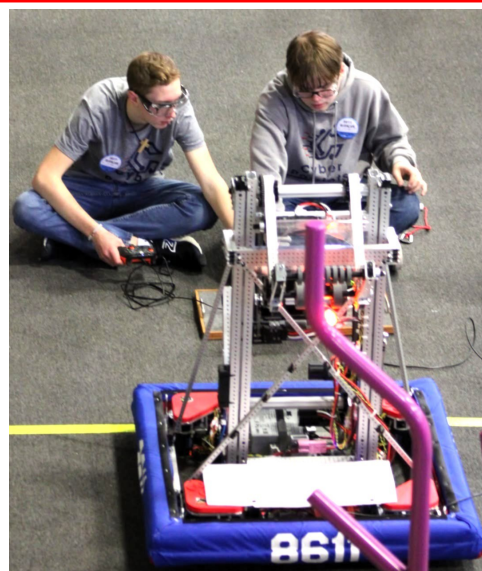
It's almost time for our 2026 kick-off for Robotics!

JV Girls Drop Season Opener in a Close Contest

On Monday, December 8, the Lady Patriots hosted the Harbor Light Christian School Swordsmen in their season opener. Despite a fantastic effort by a young Patriot team they were outscored by the Swordsmen 35-31. The Patriots jumped out to 10-4 lead with great shot selection and passing, finding the open teammate for layups in several possessions. Harbor Light caught up and had a 19-18 lead at halftime. The Patriot offense went cold in the 3rd quarter, only scoring 2 points while allowing Harbor Light to score 10. The 4th quarter was more efficient on both ends of the court, with the Patriots scoring 11 points and only allowing 6. Sophomore Trinity Brubaker hit a timely 3 late in the game, but the Patriots could not close the gap before the final buzzer.

Leading the scoring for the Patriots was eighth-grader Cailyn Brubaker with 13 points to go with her 9 rebounds. Trinity Brubaker had 11 points with 3 assists, junior Marley Shepardson added 4 points and 9 rebounds, freshman Lauren Maddick chipped in 2 points and freshman Olivia Beebe added 1 point to round out the scoring.



The Patriots only had 7 team turnovers which is an impressive start for the first game of the year. They also snagged 39 total rebounds. Coach Farmer shared that this was “an encouraging first game, despite the loss.”

The Patriots began their season on the road Thursday, December 4 when they travelled to Leland to face the Comets in their season opener. It was all Leland from the outset as the Patriots fell 73-29. Sophomore Jo Salisbury led the Patriots with 12 points and 15 rebounds, and junior Lucas Husted added 8 points and 3 steals in the effort.

On Monday, December 8, The Patriots rebounded from their loss to Leland, defeating Harbor Light Christian School JV 47-28. Junior Lucas Husted got the scoring started for the Patriots, and led all scorers with 16 points and 5 steals. Sophomore Jo Salisbury had another strong game with 14 points, 6 rebounds and 3 steals. Sophomore Brady Fekete added 8 points, 5 rebounds and 2 steals. Coach Brubaker attributed the win to excellent defense and consistent ball movement which led to many open buckets.
