CHCS Summer Reading Programs

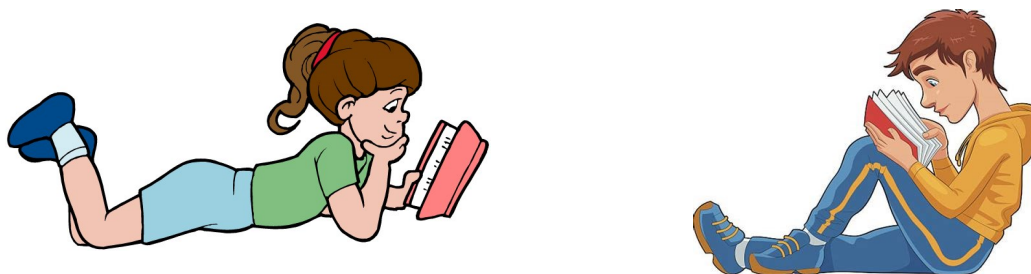
Dear Elementary Families,
