What is T.R.I.P.?

T.R.I.P. is an acrostic for Tuition Reduction



Incentive Program. This program provides the families and friends of CHCS with an opportunity to financially help our school families with their tuition and fundraising commitment as well as the General Fund.

How does it work?

Fill out the T.R.I.P. enrollment form and hand into the office. You may then purchase gift cards from the school at face value. The school purchases the cards from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a reduced price. For example, you purchase a \$25.00 Bath & Body Works gift card at face value. The school purchases the card from the scrip company for \$21.75, earning \$3.25 in a rebate. The rebates are tracked for you and applied to your account twice a year - in May and in December. It is that easy!
