**School will be dismissed at 11:30 a.m. on this day.**




## Cold Weather Apparel

CHCS Athletic Season Passes for HOME games are now available in the office.

- **Adult All-Season - \$60.00** - Entitles holder to 1 adult admittance at ALL athletic events in the 2018-2019 year.
- **Family All Season Pass - \$150.00** - Entitles holder FAMILY\* admittance at ALL athletic events in the 2018-2019 year.
  - Add 1 grandparent - additional \$35
  - Add 2 grandparents - additional \$60
- **Single Season Family Pass - \$60.00** - Entitles holder FAMILY\* admittance at FALL athletic events in the 2018-2019 year. (WINTER Season Passes will be available soon)
  - Add 1 grandparent - additional \$10
  - Add 2 grandparents - additional \$15
- **Single Sport Family Pass - \$40.00** - Entitles holder FAMILY\* admittance at ALL athletic events of **one** FALL sport of your choice (Soccer or Volleyball) in the 2018-2019 year. Specify sport upon purchase. (Basketball passes will be available soon)
  - Add 1 grandparent - additional \$10
  - Add 2 grandparents - additional \$15
