## Thrivent Choice Dollar Program

Cadillac Heritage Christian School is now registered with the Thrivent Choice Dollar Program. This program allows eligible members to direct some of Thrivent's charitable giving funds to the charity/ministry of their choice. These funds come from Thrivent's tax exempt status, and are not deducted from the member's accounts. Eligibility is based on what a member has with Thrivent as well as the size of those accounts.

In general, there are two ways to qualify:

1. Own an annuity with a cash value of \$20,000 or more, or
2. Own a Thrivent life or health insurance policy with annual premiums of \$750 or more.

Eligible members have until the end of March to designate 2018 dollars, and if both spouses are eligible, they'll have to direct their dollars individually. They can do so by calling 800-847-4826 or logging onto their account at [Thrivent.com](http://Thrivent.com).

The recipients of this award were recognized at the MMSL tournament on Saturday, March 16.

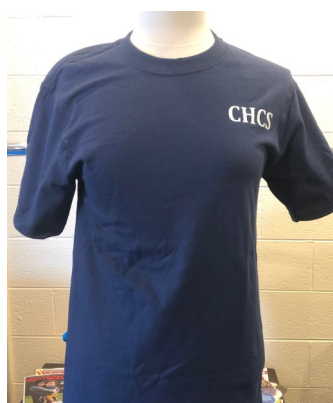
