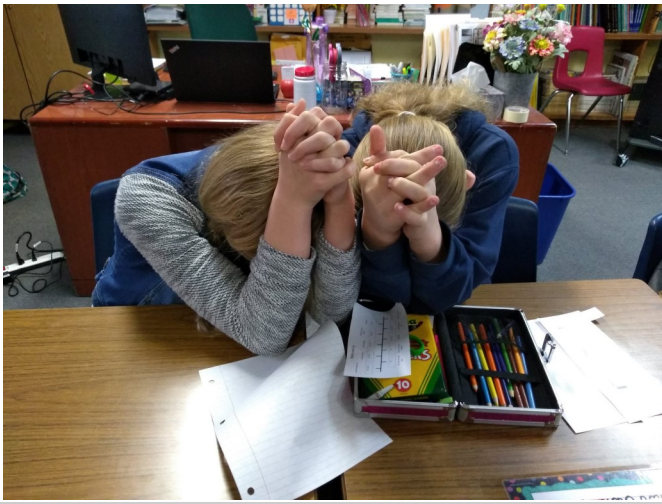


National Day of Prayer

This is the 50th year that Farm Bureau has sponsored this contest. CHCS has participated in the contest for so many years that next year we will receive a second plaque for the winner’s names.

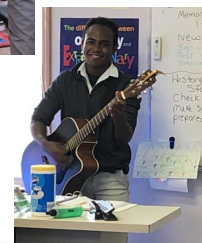
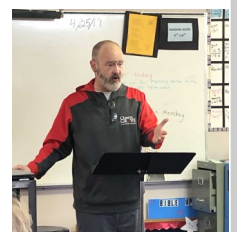
As the first place winner, Caleb Downey’s picture and name will be added to the plaque! The plaque is on display in the office.
