### **Hoops and Loops Day**






On Tuesday, September 21, CHCS hosted Harbor Light Christian School. Heading into the match, the Lady


Patriots focused on their chemistry and consistency. That turned out to be the key as the Lady Patriots won the match 25-14, 25-19, 22-25, and 25-15.
