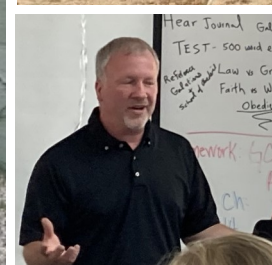

The CHCS high school volleyball team hosted Beth Haven Baptist Academy on Friday, September 17. At the start of the night, there was no question that there was going to be a Patriot victory. Unfortunately, it was the Lady Patriots of Beth Haven that came out on top, winning the match in three sets.

If there were two things Heritage could take away from their match against Beth Haven, they would be to improve on their team communication and consistency.

The Heritage ladies kept things close in the first set, making Beth Haven work hard to close the set with a score of 26-24. Despite their efforts, the consistency of Beth Haven swayed the match in their favor, as they took the next two sets 25-15 and 25-21.



On Tuesday, September 21, CHCS hosted Harbor Light Christian School. Heading into the match, the Lady Patriots focused on their chemistry and consistency. That turned out to be the key as the Lady Patriots won the match 25-14, 25-19, 22-25, and 25-15.

It was evident from the start that Heritage was ready for the win. The players came out strong, keeping their passes on target and setting up the plays. One of the biggest highlights of the night was

the strong serving that Heritage demonstrated. Five athletes contributed to the teams 32 aces. Junior Natalie Vandenberg led the team with 25 completed serves, including 10 aces on the night. Senior Mackenzie Vrieze was right behind, tacking on another 9 aces of her own. Junior Desirae Vrieze was consistent, completing seven positive serves, including 4 aces. Sophomore Regan Farmer completed 22 serves with 5 aces. Sophomore Malia Husted tacked on 3 more aces and Junior Riley Husted contributed another ace of her own.

The win against Harbor Light proved to the Lady Patriots that they have the ability to reach their goal when they work together as a team unit!
