CHCS dropped a close 25-19, 19-25, 21-25, 22-25 match to Grand Traverse Academy on Friday, October 8. The Patriots came out strong in the first match, playing good defense against the heavy hitting Mustangs. Junior Kendall



Meekhof racked up some powerful kills of her own and the team kept their serving consistent to come away with the first set win. The tables turned in the second set as GTA stepped up the offensive attack to take the win. The Patriots fought hard in sets three and four, but several unforced serving errors ultimately cost the Patriots the match.

On Tuesday, October 12, CHCS visited Daystar Academy in their second face-off of the season, where it was evident that the Warriors were determined to not fall to the Patriots a second time.

Senior Mackenzie Vrieze was 17 of 21 from the serving line, racking up 11 aces to lead the team. Despite the Patriots' strong serving in sets one and two, Daystar took an early lead, trumping the Patriots 24-26 and

23-25. Things weren't looking good for the Patriots in the third set, but they dug deep and came from behind to win a close set, 25-22. The Warriors were committed to the win and outplayed the Patriots in set 4 to take the match with a 20-25 victory.

The two losses dropped the Patriots record to 6-4. The Lady Patriots will be back in action as they host Boyne Falls on Thursday, October 14 at 6:00 p.m.

### Elementary & Junior High Boys Basketball Starting Soon!


