



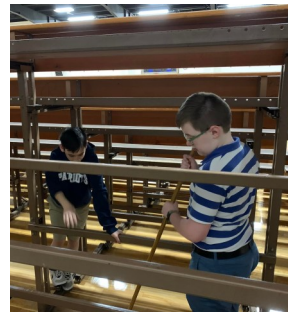

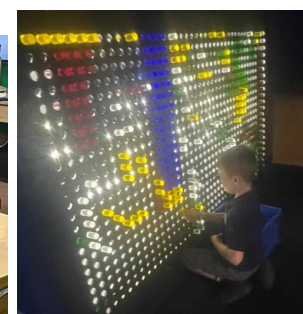


Elementary Field Day

Patriots Lose Tough Match To Warriors

Our CHCS Patriot Girls hosted Buckley in a back-and-forth battle that ended with Buckley on top 1-0. The Bears were missing four starters due to a track meet, and senior captain Mackenzie Vrieze was not able to play for CHCS due to sickness. This left the Patriots with no subs for the



game, and Coach Stagg was proud of the way the girls persevered, especially the new sixth and eighth grade players. There was a lot of ball movement by both teams throughout the game, but Buckley brought the ball within shooting range on several occasions, leading to junior Brenna Silver's fourteen saves in the net. The score was tied 0-0 as the second half started, until Buckley was able to put a shot to the back of the net, scoring the only goal of the game. "I was proud of our fullbacks and Brenna as they shut down Buckley's advances on the goal throughout the game," Coach Stagg said. "We will continue to work on building up our confidence in front of the net on the offensive end."

The loss brings the Patriots' record to 1-3. CHCS travels to Roscommon on Friday for their next match.
