Both teams controlled the ball fairly evenly throughout the match, testing the keepers on both ends with fast breaks and periodic shots on goal.

At the end of the first half the game was scoreless. In the second half, the CHCS Patriots scored on a fast break that started with a lead by Sebastian Vrieze to Peyton Shaffer who drove it into the back of the net. Pine River had several shots on goal and in the final minutes of the game, scored, tying the game at 1-1. Keeper Peyton Nickel had 6 saves on the night for CHCS.

Coach Stagg was impressed with his team in their first game of the season, "We are just starting to gel as a team, and our younger and less experienced players put forth a great effort tonight! We were impressed with the good attitudes displayed by both teams. It was a fun match, and we love playing teams like Pine River that play hard, but also demonstrate positive character on the field!"

Senior Peyton Nickel had two saves on the night in the goal. Seventh grader Josiah Salisbury had one save as keeper in the second half.

Coach Stagg was relieved when the Patriots finally turned the corner and began to play with confidence after the opening goal, "Pineview came out dominating the game, and I didn't know how things would turn out, until Seth Wanner scored the first goal, and we got back into the match." The win against Pineview brings the CHCS Patriots' record to 1-0-1. The Patriots' next game is hosted by Skeels on Tuesday, August 30.
