Patriots Top Eagles


The Patriots won a home matchup on Tuesday, January 24 against the visiting Skeels Christian School Eagles. The final score was 47-21. Defense was the name of the game for the Patriots as they held their opponent to 11 first half points (only 3 in the second quarter). Peyton Shaffer once again led all scorers with 21 points, shooting 4-7 from three-point range. Peyton Nickel notched his first double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds. Sebastian Vrieze also added 10 points and 9 rebounds, narrowly missing his first double-double of the season. Jadon Salisbury returned to the line up after an elbow injury sidelined him for a couple weeks. He added 6 points and 4 blocks in a solid defensive effort.

Coach Brubaker commented, "We put together a solid performance defensively, which allowed us to get rolling after a bit of a slow start. I am continually impressed with the effort these young men put in, their ability to drive hard to the basket, and the physical level

of play that allows them to outrebound their opponents almost every game (we outrebounded Skeels 41-21, with 22 of our rebounds coming on the offensive side of the ball). We need to clean up the turnovers and learn to finish by the basket, but overall, these young men are fun to coach and exciting to watch."

The win on Tuesday improved the Patriots' record to 4-2. The CHCS Patriots have another

home match-up on Thursday, January 26 with a tough TCBAA squad, who defeated the Patriots just two weeks ago.
