The Cadillac Heritage Christian School Patriots hosted the TCBA Bulldogs in girls soccer on Tuesday, May 9, ending in a 0-1 loss. TCBA controlled the ball throughout much of the first half and scored, ending the half ahead 1-0. The Patriots turned their game around in the second half, maintaining control on the Bulldogs end of the field and taking a few shots on goal, but unable to score. The CHCS defense shut down TCBA's attacks, finishing the game 0-1. Senior goalkeeper Brenna Silvers had 9 saves on the night.



Coach Stagg commented, "We once again came out with a slow start tonight, allowing the goal during the first half. After some corrections, we put the pressure on in the second half, controlling the ball and setting up some opportunities in front of the net. I commend both teams for great sportsmanship tonight, and great improvement by several of our younger players!"

The loss tonight lowered the Patriots' record to 0-3-2 for the season. The CHCS JV team hosts Crossroads on Friday, May 12 at 5:00 p.m.
