What's the Story Behind the Club's Name?

Shortly after William Digby founded the town of Lafayette, it became the principle trade city on the Wabash River. The Wabash & Erie Canal also terminated close to Lafayette. At this time, Indiana was "The West," and since Cincinnati was known as being the "Queen City of The West," Lafayette became known as the "Star City of the West." The name remained associated with Lafayette, Indiana through the early 1970s. Star City Corvettes derives its name from this legend.

What is Star City Corvettes?

Star City Corvettes is a non- profit organization whose primary purposes are to plan events, trips, and activities for its members and their families; to encourage the exchange of information regarding the operation, maintenance, restoration, and use of the Corvette; to encourage good driving habits on public highways. The Club also supports various local charities.

Who Can Join?

- The member must over the age of 21 and the title of the corvette must be recorded with his /her name.
- If the person is, or has ever been a member of the National Council of Corvette Clubs (NCCC) then he/she may submit an application.

What are the membership Fees?

- Star City Corvettes membership dues are \$24.00 per year.
- Dues for a new member are due after being accepted as a SCC Member. The new member will be charged at the rate of \$2.00 per month for each remaining month in the calendar year plus a one-time initiation fee of \$10.00 and the current cost of a SCC name badge.
- Spouse membership in SCC is available at \$2.00 per month plus initiation and NCCC for \$10.00 per year.
- Renewal fees are invoiced to all members for payment in September and due by October 31st.

Meetings, Social and Other Events:

- The SCC business meeting is scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 7:00 PM.

- The club attends car shows and schedules trips during the year. For example, the club may go to Bloomington Gold, the National Corvette Museum or other fun-filled corvette destinations.
- SCC organizes Vettes for Vets at the West Lafayette, Indiana Veterans Home the first week in May. The club supports other clubs who sponsor veteran appreciation car shows and fundraisers.
- SCC participates in various parades, cruise' ins, car shows at nursing homes, high school homecomings, NCCC events and more.
- The last social event of the year is the Christmas Party & Awards Banquet.
- Although we encourage everyone to participate in scheduled events, there is no minimum number of meetings or events required to maintain your status as active members.
