Prequel Day, Friday, October 23: Arrive in Bucharest

After arrival in Bucharest, transfer at your convenience to the historic downtown to check-in and freshen up before a relaxed orientation tour. In the evening, meet for cocktails and an optional light supper at Caru cu Bere.

After a relaxed breakfast, tour the sights of Bucharest. In the afternoon, you have the option to relax at the hotel or join the group visiting Primaverii Palace, home of Romania's last Communist dictator. Day One, Saturday, October 24: Arrive in Bucharest

After arrival in Bucharest, transfer at your convenience to the historic downtown to check-in and freshen up. Day Two, Sunday, October 25: Peles Castle

After breakfast, check out and transfer to the Gara de Nord, Bucharest's old railway terminal.



Take the train north through the Ploesti oil fields, pivotal in World War II history. Our destination is the town of Sinaia in the Carpathian Mountains, where we will visit Peles Castle, a masterpiece of German neo-Renaissance architecture and one of the most stunning castles in Europe. Commissioned by King Carol I in 1873 and completed in 1883, the castle served as the summer residence of the royal family until 1947. Its 160 rooms are adorned with the finest examples of European art, Murano crystal chandeliers, German stained-glass windows and Cordoba leather-covered walls. After a lunch break

on your own, our transport will take us over the Carpathians deep into Transylvania. Our accommodations and dinner await at the guesthouses of Count Kalnoky and of Charles, the Prince of Wales.

Day Three, Monday, October 26: Brasov & Count Dracula's Castle

After a hearty country breakfast, visit the town of Brasov. Frozen in time, the town is a delightful blend of Renaissance, Baroque, Provincial and neoClassical styles. Explore the medieval castle



of Brasov, formerly one of Europe's most secure fortresses, with the preserved Black and White Towers and the Weaver's Bastion. In the afternoon, prepare for a visit of Bran Castle. Surrounded by an aura of mystery and legend and perched high atop a 200-foot-high rock, the 14th century castle owes its fame to its imposing towers and turrets as well as to the myth created around Bram Stocker's Dracula. Following a visit of the castle and its surroundings we will enjoy a private gala dinner

inside the castle walls. (Two hotel rooms will be at our disposal to dress for dinner.)

Day Four, Tuesday, October 27: Sighişoara

After another country breakfast, we will wind through the Transylvanian hills to Sighisoara, a World Heritage site rumored to be the birthplace of Dracula, and one of the best-preserved fortified medieval towns in Europe. Burgher houses and ornate churches line its cobbled streets. After a lunch break on your own, continue on to the Hungarian border and the town of Oradea for supper and our overnight.

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Day Five, Wednesday, October 28: Hungary and Budapest

After breakfast this morning, our journey starts at the Hungarian railway platform where our luxurious time machine awaits. Walk on the red carpet to board the Vintage Majestic Imperator Train de Luxe where hot coffee and cold “Sekt” -sparkling wine - welcome us. As soon as we are all aboard, our magnificent iron palace will speed us across the Hungarian plains.



A fabulous lunch is served en route. Upon arrival in Budapest's railway terminal, transfer to the hotel. In the evening, enjoy the strains of gypsy music, before boarding our Danube riverboat for a dinner tour of Budapest. Comfortable beds await in our Budapest hotel. Meals: Breakfast, coffee and Sekt, lunch, dinner O/N Budapest

Day Six, Thursday, October 29: Austro-Hungary

After breakfast, board the Majestic Imperator for the journey through the Danube Valley to the border of Slovakia. Meet our futuristic REX train for the short hop across the border, to the capital city of Bratislava. Here we will step back in time to Central Europe of 1922. The town is dominated by towers and facades exhibiting styles from the baroque to Art Nouveau and Hungarian Secessionist. Before visiting the city center, lunch awaits in Bratislavská Restaurácia. Back on board the train, the bar is open as we wind our way along the Danube River. Our final destination is the seat of the Austro-Hungarian Empire: Vienna. Before disembarking, enjoy a festive dinner on our private train. Transfer to your accommodations in Vienna.

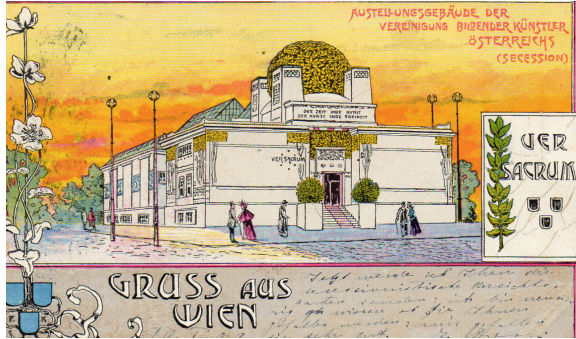
Day Seven, Friday, October 30: Departure

First Sequel Day, Friday, October 30: Vienna

After a sumptuous breakfast, get on your vintage motoring coat so we can enjoy the imperial city by open electric motorcar. Zip through the tiniest alleys and motor on the grandest boulevards as we explore this city of architectural splendor. View St. Stephen's Cathedral, Kaertnerstrasse, the State Opera House, the Museum Quarter, Rathaus... End the motor tour at the Hofburg – the City Palace – to visit the Royal Treasury and the Imperial Apartments of Franz Josef and Sisi. For those with strong constitutions, optionally visit the imperial crypt beneath the Capuchin Church. The evening is ours to optionally enjoy a musical offering in the



renowned Musikverein or the grand State Opera. Afterwards, dinner awaits in the vaults of the Zwölfpostelkeller deep below the streets of the old town.

Second Sequel Day, Saturday, October 31: Vienna

After another relaxed breakfast, reserved seats await at the Spanish Riding School. Watch the famous Lipizzaner stallions go through their exercises as if ballerinas on stage. In the afternoon, Vienna is yours to explore at your leisure. Most of us will opt to take the streetcar to the Upper Belvedere Palace to pay our respects to Gustav Klimt and other great artists. The Palace offers a spectacular view of the city and the grounds are magical any time of year.



Other museum options include the Albertina, the Sigmund Freud House, the Funeral Museum, the Third Man Museum, the Viktor Frankl House, the Klimt Villa, the Museum of Applied Arts, Transport Museum, Carriage Museum, or the marvelous Secession. For those interested, optional cocktails will be served on the Ferris wheel in the Prater Park (limited to 15 guests). The evening is reserved for a final optional musical offering before a farewell dinner in the dining room of the Sacher Hotel.
