Toward a Pastoral Change of Heart Widespread Consultation with the People of God 2025

Purpose: To invite as many Catholics into the conversation about the future of the Church of Philadelphia as possible. Specifically, the consultation seeks to:

- 1. Build understanding of our current landscape and the vision behind the Fourth Way
- 2. Begin to identify communities and lay leaders interested in supporting this vision
- 3. Surface questions, concerns, and ideas to continuously develop the vision
- 4. Contribute toward the development of a comprehensive view of parish life today

Overall Framework:

Using the Archbishop's pastoral letter released on the Feast of St. John Neumann (January 5) as a foundational text, there will be three primary methods for consultation between January and June 2025:

Parish-hosted Sessions (February - June):

- **Purpose:** To engage parish leaders and parishioners in reading and discussing the Archbishop's pastoral letter and the vision
- **Format:** Two-hour session including prayer, a video presentation, small-group conversation. Each parish is asked to host at least two (2) discussions. Parishes are welcome to host additional sessions.
- Resources: Agenda, materials inclusive of talking points, handouts, and feedback
 collection tools will be provided by Catholic Leadership Institute in English,
 Spanish, and Vietnamese. CLI facilitators are available upon request.

Archdiocesan-hosted Sessions (February - June):

- **Purpose:** To provide larger, cross-parish opportunities for people to understand the vision and share questions, concerns, and ideas.
- **Format:** Two-hour session including prayer, a video presentation, small-group conversation, large-group question and answer.
- **Timeframe:** Weekday evenings (Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays) at 6:30pm-8:30pm, Saturday mornings (9am-11am or 10am-12pm), Sunday afternoons (1pm-3pm or 4pm-6pm).
- **Accessibility:** Sessions will be offered in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, and ASL.
- **Locations:** High schools, parishes, other venues.
- **Registration:** Parishes can register as a group/delegation, or individuals may register on their own. Registration resources will be forwarded to each Parish Point of Contact (PPOC).

Disciple Maker Index Survey (Ash Wednesday - Palm Sunday):

- **Purpose:** To see growth and change since 2022 through a 10-12 minute survey of Catholics across the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.
- **Format:** Available electronically and via paper surveys in 18 different languages.
- **Distribution:** Information will be provided to pastors and parish point of contact in January.
