

<u>All Saints Day + Commemoration of the</u> Faithful Departed!

This weekend marks the beginning of November; it will be a busy month at St. Lawrence Parish, and I hope you can participate in as many of these events as you can. The following will help you track those activities:

- 11/1/25: All Saints Day: because it falls on a Saturday, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation.
- 11/2/5: All Souls Day: because it falls on a Sunday, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation.
- 11/5/25: Pastoral Visit by Msgr. John Marine. During his visit, Msgr. Marine will interview the Pastor, review the sacramental records, inspect the parish campus, and conclude the day by participating in a combined meeting of the Pastoral Council and Finance Council.
