FINANCIAL CRIMES by Deception or Coercion aka SCAMS

Automatic/Robo Calls:

- "This is _____ from Card Services" -pretending to be from your credit card company.
- "Your Social Security Number has been cancelled and you need to call (123)456-7890 immediately"
- "This is the IRS and you have overdue taxes and payment is required immediately"
- "This is _____ from Student Loans Repayment......"
- "This is _____ with Apple Support and there is suspicious activity on your iCloud"
- "I'm calling from dealer services regarding your vehicle warranty"
- One Ring Call Scam 1 ring and hang-up, hoping for a call back to an automated message scam.

In all of these scams they are trying to get you to submit bank/credit card or personal ID info (identity theft).

Different Types of Financial Scams:

- Requests for Payment Someone contacts you regarding payment for: Bond money for a family member, in lieu
 of being arrested/arrest warrant being issued for you, Delinquent taxes (IRS), or any number of other scenarios.
 They request payment with Gift Cards, Pre-Paid Credit Cards, Money Packs, Western Union, Google Play Cards,
 iTunes Cards, etc. They frequently ask for one amount and then if you do it, they demand more.
- Overpayment scams Someone sends you a check, instructs you to deposit it in your bank account, and wire part
 of the money back to them. But the check was fake, so you'll have to pay your bank the amount of the check, plus
 you'll lose any money you wired.
- <u>Unsolicited check fraud</u> A scammer sends you a check for no reason. If you cash it, you may be authorizing the
 purchase of items or signing up for a loan you didn't ask for.
- <u>Automatic withdrawals</u> A scam company requests and sets up automatic withdrawals from your bank account to qualify for a free trial or to collect a prize.
- Phishing You receive an email message that asks you to verify your bank account or debit card number.
- <u>Charity Scams</u> Some scammers set up fake organizations to take advantage of the public's generosity. They
 especially take advantage of tragedies/disasters, and support for veterans/public servants.
- Bond Money for family member/grandchild Someone calls or shows up at your residence saying someone you
 know has been arrested and that they sent you there to get money to bond them out of jail and need cash
 immediately.
- Spoofing Phone Numbers computer generated replica phone numbers. You may get a call from a number you
 know/recognize, computer programs exist that allow scammers to choose the number that shows up on caller ID.

Tips for recognizing or dealing with potential Scams:

- Law Enforcement, Government Agencies, Credit Card/Bank Institutions will not contact you and demand immediate payment for anything.
- Trust your intuition if it seems suspicious, wrong, or too good to be true.....it probably is.
- NEVER buy gift/money/Google/iTunes/Prepaid Cards and send the numbers to someone for payment.
- Report suspected scams to the Federal Trade Commission www.ftc.gov
- In the event of losing money in a scam report it to local Law Enforcement, you are likely out the money.




