Luckily My Great Friend Dave Grommon, who had helped with the '41 Cady, also got excited & offered to drop everything in Louisiana & help with the prep!

Typical of many car fixes – the more we did the more we found she needed! What started as a get her going dependably & reliably got Deeper & Deeper until it was a body off restoration of the whole car. Mechanically - It was a disaster with the engine needing a full rebuild, the transmission had a broken 2nd gear, the rear end needed bearings and the brakes needed everything. The English carb was missing parts, the magneto was not functional and every bit of the wiring in the whole car was bad. So mechanically everything needed to be done before the June '84 race! As far as cosmetics the whole car was covered in thick black enamel including most chrome (it was called a British Restoration or in my book a Dupont Rebuild) and the top was in shreds. 
