Presidents Message – June 2025

What a weekend!!! Let me start by thanking everyone who attended our monthly swap meet meetings. Upon presenting this idea to the club members, it was voted on and decided to make the move and give our Swap Meet another try for May 2025. The clock started ticking because this meant we only had seven short months to prepare as compared to a whole year.

With cool and cloudy skies on Friday, May 16, the CRRAACA Swap Meet returned back to Hawkeye Downs after a 5-year absence. We had great help with advertising from Aaron Frank and Kyle Askam, two frequent Swap Meet and club participants. One has joined and we are working on the other one. And of course, location, location helped to draw a large number of vendors and patrons back to the Swap Meet.

As always, the Cedar Rapids' Region members stepped up on Friday to begin the initial preparations as we marked the exhibition hall floor to welcome vendors coming in at 12 pm. Club members again came out to help on Saturday, May 17, starting at 3-4 am as outside vendors lined up for the race track and as the inside of the Exhibition Hall quickly filled up.

Total number of vendors equaled 184 and this included some of the vendors who had multiple stalls as on the track with many having two spaces. Total number of patrons equaled 1,130. We heard a resounding comment from vendors and patrons, "We are glad you are back!" On Saturday, Hawkeye Downs offered the following dates for next year: April 4 (Easter), May 2, May 16, and May 23 (Memorial Day weekend). Considering those dates and the successful outcome of the Swap Meet the CRRAACA Board, voted to present to the club members at the June meeting the proposed date of Saturday, May 16, 2026 for next year's Swap Meet if the club members wish to discuss and then vote on continuing with offering the Swap Meet. The May 16 date is being tentatively held for us by Hawkeye Downs until we get back to them with our decision. At the June meeting, Sylvia will present the final dollar

Again, Kathi and I cannot thank enough every one of our club members who helped make this event a HUGE success!!


