## Supplies: <br> Fabrics

Fabric scissors
Neutral thread
Straight pins (or clips)
Omnigrid $6 \times 24$ inch ruler
Omnigrid 6-1/2 inch square ruler
Omnigrid Fons \& Porter Half-Square \& Quarter Square Ruler
Sewing Machine
1/4 inch foot

## Learning experience:

Making Quarter Square Triangle units using the Omnigrid Fons \& Porter Half-Square \& Quarter Square Ruler. (See the Techniques page of the website to download how to use this ruler.)

## 12-inch block

For each block cut:
Light: Four 4-1/2 inch squares and eight quarter square triangles (my cream)
Medium: One 4-1/2 inch block (my light purple)
Dark: Eight quarter square triangles (my dark purple)
To cut the quarter square triangles:
Cut a strip that is $21 / 2$ inches wide of both the light and dark fabrics. Following the 4-inch line on the ruler, cut into the 8 triangles of each fabric.


Sew together in rows, pressing the seams toward the square.

To make the quarter squares, lay out the triangles to form the square; sew 2 diagonal triangles together; sew the two larger triangle units together.


Sew the rows together; pressing the seams toward the center.
