> I'm writing as a follow-up to our discussion of two weeks ago regarding cable routes.

>

> First, I wanted to let you know that we have incorporated your feedback into our design and are now planning to survey three potential south shore landfalls, in addition to our two bay-side options. In total, we are now planning to survey the following five routes:

- > * Fresh Pond Rd
- > * Promised Land Fish Meal Factory (Napeague State Park)
- > * Wainscott Beach (Town Line Road)
- > * Napeague Lane
- > * Hither Hills Campground

> Our planned survey corridors are shown in the attached map, which will be submitted to the U.S. Bureau of Ocean Energy Management next week in connection with our application for permission to conduct offshore surveys.

> Second, I'd like to request your guidance on presenting this publicly. We will be holding another open house in the next 4 - 8 weeks, after we've done more of our homework with each of these communities. We will be making this map public then. If appropriate, I would also be happy to give a presentation to the Fisheries Advisory Committee and/or any other body of the Board that you think is appropriate. I plan to reach out separately to the Trustees to update them, but wanted to give you an opportunity to have us come in and present to the town first. Please let us know how you'd like us to proceed.

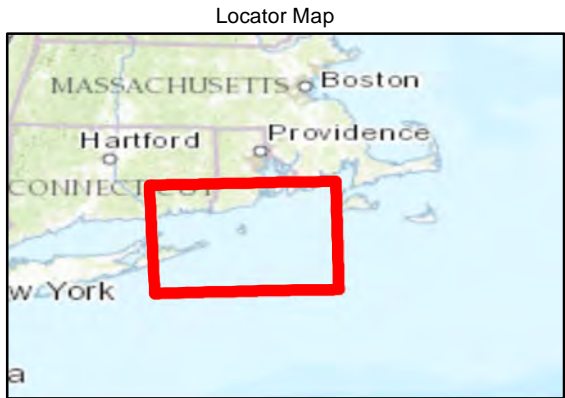
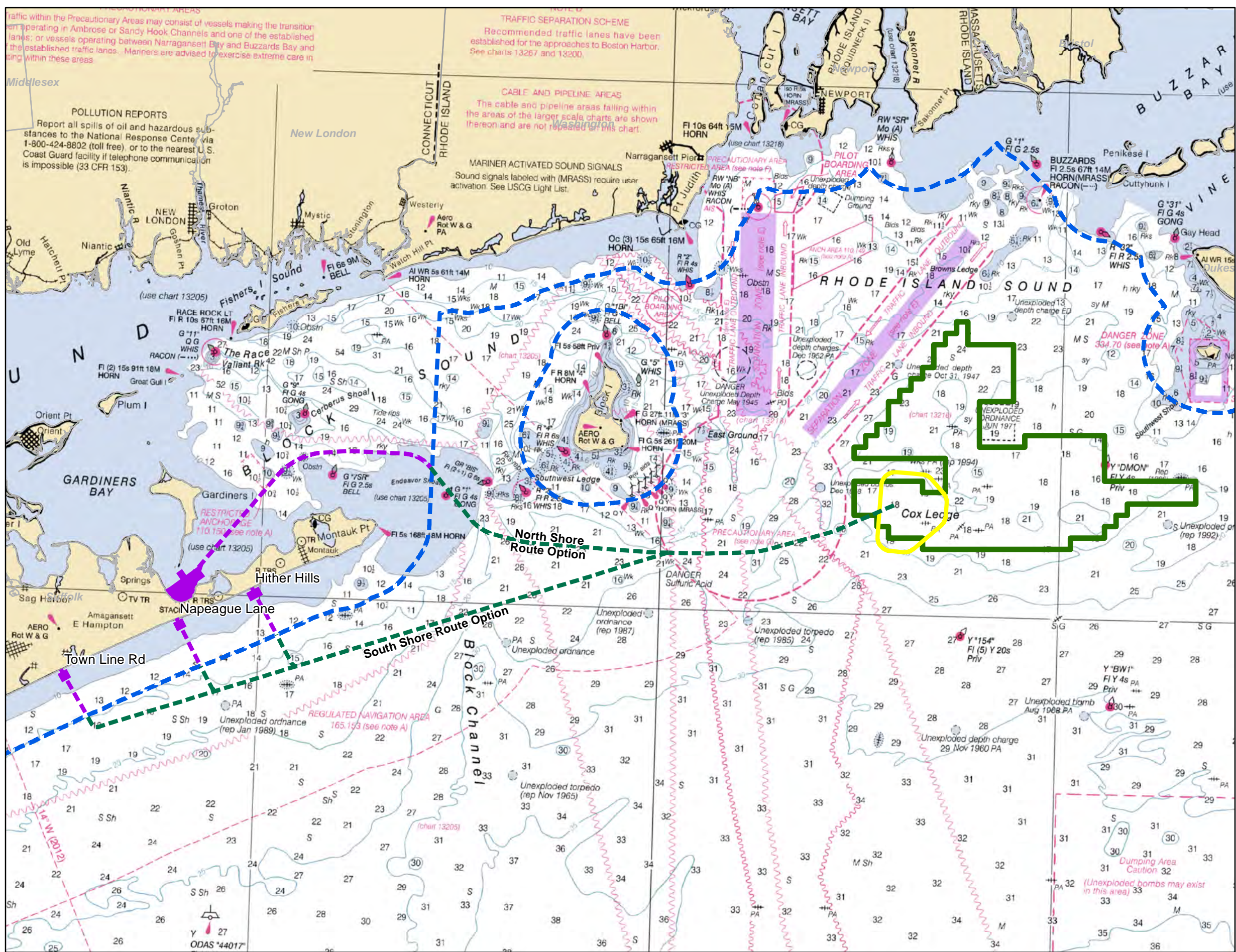

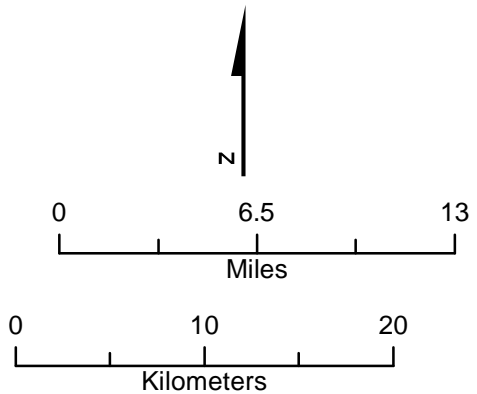
