Rehearsal Expectations

Rehearsals are a vital part of the production process. Please read and follow these guidelines carefully:

- Attendance All rehearsals are compulsory unless excused by the director.
- Punctuality Arrive on time out of respect for your fellow cast and crew.
- Preparation Bring your script and materials. Review lines, songs, and choreography in advance.
- Focus Stay attentive, ask questions, and use rehearsal time productively.
- Teamwork Theatre is collaborative; support and encourage one another.
- Lead Roles Learn lines promptly to allow focus on character and stage work.
- Commitment Consistent attendance is essential. Missing excessive rehearsals may result in recasting.
- One Production Only To ensure full commitment, performers should not participate in multiple shows at the same time.

Rehearsals

Rehearsals commence Friday 24 October and Saturday 25 October.

Lead roles & cast aged 12+: Saturdays, 3:00pm-5:00pm

Option: Over 12s may attend Fridays if needed.

Cast aged 11 & under: Fridays, 5:30pm-7:00pm

Option: Under 11s may attend Saturdays if unable to make Fridays.

Contribution: \$25 per 1.5-hour rehearsal
