**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
B5014 LICHFIELD ROAD, ABBOTS BROMLEY AND MILL GREEN**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 20 July 2021 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of B5014 Lichfield Road in Abbots Bromley and Mill Green from its junction with B5234 Ashbrook Lane to a point outside property known as Thyme House unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via B5234 Ashbrook Lane, B5234 Bromley Road, B5234 Church Lane, B5234 Duffield Lane, B5234 Burton Road, A515 Sudbury Road, A515 Wood Lane, A515 King Street, A515 Main Street, A515 Bond End, A515 Lichfield Road, A515 Yoxall Road, A515 Lichfield Road, A513 Rugeley Road, A513 Kings Bromley Lane, B5014 Uttoxeter Road, B5014 Rake End, B5014 Uttoxeter Road, B5014 Lichfield Road and vice versa. The order will come into operation on 26 July 2021 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 July 2021.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the new gas service works undertaken by Cadent, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
