



Fort Stockton Barrio Fest Baseball Queen Scholarship 2026



Purpose: To provide One (1) college scholarship of \$500 to an incoming Senior at Fort Stockton High School.

Award: One (1) scholarship will be awarded to a (1) person as the Barrio Fest Baseball Queen. *(If ineligibility occurs, the next-in-line is recipient)*

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be entering as a Senior at Fort Stockton High School for the Fall of 2026.
2. Applicant must be Bi-Lingual, speaking & understanding English & Spanish to a varying degree
3. Applicant must attend 3 events to qualify- *see below for choices
4. Applicant must enroll into College after High School, funds to be distributed directly to College
5. Applicant must submit ALL completed items by the deadline **(Friday, September 4th 2026)**.
6. Applicant must satisfy school attendance requirements *(End of Year)*
7. Applicant must have a passing grade & graduate *(End of Year)*

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Essays and Application **must be typed**, single-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman, with numbered pages and one-inch margins. *Questionnaire can be handwritten*

ESSAY PROMPT: In 150-250 words, write a short essay in English or Spanish responding to the following topic: Describe how Hispanic heritage, surrounding Hispanic families, and the Fort Stockton Hispanic culture have impacted your desire and motivation to obtain a college degree.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT & CHOICES: **CONTESTANT MUST ATTEND 1 EVENT (of your choice) AND IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND 2 OTHER EVENTS TO QUALIFY**
BE 30 MINUTES EARLY *(Sign in Required)*

Event Choice 1 - Barrio Fest Reception Social **Friday, September 11th at 6pm** *(COMMUNITY THEATRE ON NELSON)*

- Dress Code: Contestant must wear a Mexican/Hispanic Spirited outfit (Creative or Traditional)
 - Judges will be on site to gauge interaction and social skills with the crowd, including Bi-Lingual capacity
 - Short introductions will be made during the reception

REQUIRED - Barrio Fest Baseball Ceremony Event **Saturday September 12th at 9am** *(BASEBALL FIELDS ROONEY PARK)*

- Dress Code: Contestant must wear a Mexican/Hispanic Spirited outfit (Creative or Traditional)
 - Judges will be at the Baseball Ceremony to rank spirited outfits and social skills with the crowd, including Bi-Lingual capacity
 - Short Introductions will be made & will assist in providing gifts to returning players

Event Choice 2 – Barrio Fest Help Booth & Walk Around **Saturday September 13th – 3 shifts** *(NELSON STREET IN FRONT OF COMMUNITY THEATRE)*

- Dress Code: Contestant must wear a Mexican/Hispanic Spirited outfit (Creative or Traditional)
- **1ST Shift: 1:30pm – 2:30pm** / **2nd Shift: 2:30pm – 3:30pm** / **3rd Shift: 3:30pm – 4:30pm**
 - Judges will be walking around or staged to gauge interaction and social skills with the crowd, including Bi-Lingual capacity & representation.

REQUIRED - Barrio Fest Crowning Event on Nelson Street Stage, **Saturday September 12th at 5pm**

- Dress Code: Contestant must wear a Mexican/Hispanic Spirited outfit (Creative or Traditional)
