Families can celebrate National Water Day by exploring the water cycle and making wooden peace signs—included with admission!

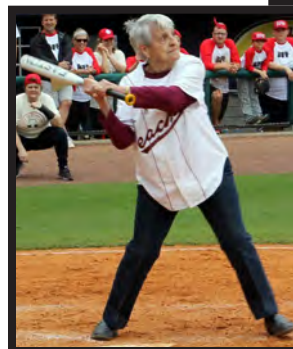
