The First Building

Harvey Jones built this Chapel as a place of worship for Bernice, marking the beginning of Har-Ber Village. Built in 1968, the bricks were handmade before the Civil War for three huge fireplaces in the old VanWinkle home in Arkansas. The pulpit came from the Zion Methodist Church, built in 1850, six miles southeast of Springdale, Arkansas. The glass windows were made in Fort Smith, Arkansas, especially for the Chapel.

The statue of Christ, 10 feet high, was carved in white marble in Italy. It faces the waters of Grand Lake with outstretched arms welcoming all who come to Him.

While relatively small, the Chapel is available for weddings.

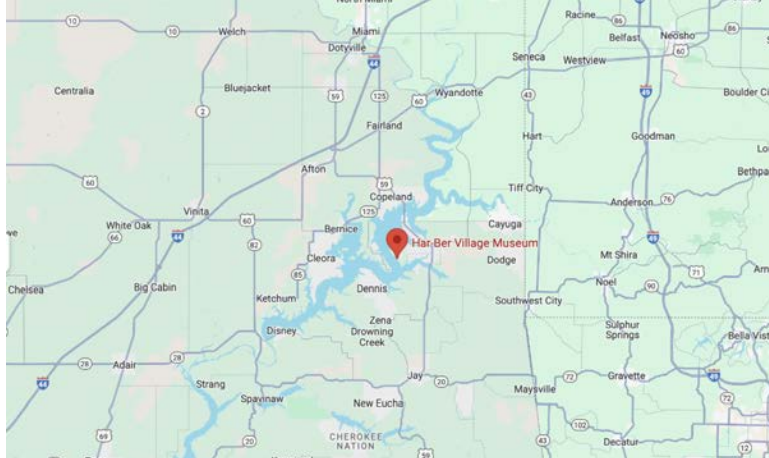
