Renovations continue...

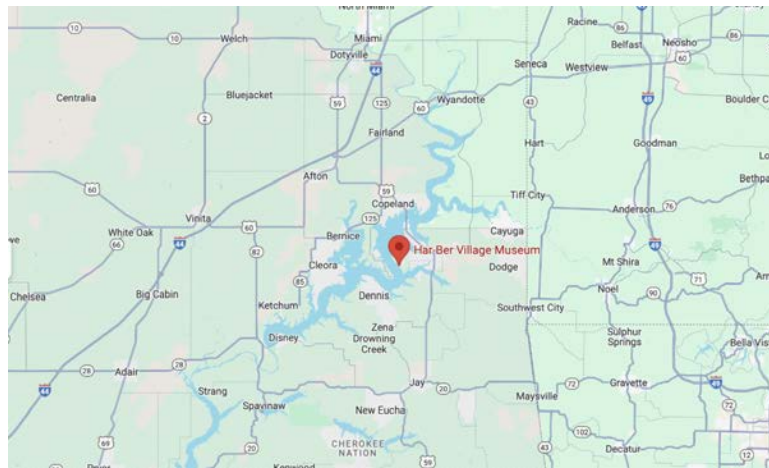
