GENERAL COMMUNICATIONS

TO HAIL SHIP/PORT
[Name of boat/marina being hailed - X3]
THIS IS [Vessel name - X3]
OVER
- Wait for response
IO SWITCH TO WORKING CHANNEL
[Name of boat/marina being hailed]
THIS IS [Vessel name]
SWITCH TO CHANNEL [Working channel]
OVER
- Wait for response before switching to working channel
IVESSEL name] - OUT
[Vessel name] - OUT



DISTRESS COMMUNICATIONS



Notice of navigational hazards, weather alerts. (Pronounced: SAY-CURE-IT-TAY)

Urgency but not life-threatening. (Person overboard, mechanical/operation issues)

Life threatening, immediate assistance required. (Sinking, fire on board, medical emergency)
