

Charitable Class II Gaming Information Brochure

In accordance with the *Ho-Chunk Nation Gaming Ordinance*, Sec. 7 d.

"Charitable gaming" means any authorized gaming conducted by a Ho-Chunk Nation organization on the Nation's lands for the benefit of the general welfare programs or for the benefit of Tribal Members.

The following information is provided for all religious, charitable, or social organizations wishing to conduct Class II gaming (bingo) on the Nation's lands for fundraising purposes.

Organizations wishing to conduct charitable bingo fundraisers on the Nation's lands are required to complete the *Charitable Class II Gaming Application*. A *Charitable Class II Gaming Summary* form will be provided at the time of application.

A. Charitable Class II Gaming Application.

Information includes, but is not limited to:

- Type of organization
- Organization's name and address
- Articles, bylaws, constitution or charter
- Membership total and how many members are enrolled HCN members
- Officers of organization
- Purpose and major activities of organization
- Facility where the organization would like to hold their fundraiser
- Date and time of event(s)
- Supervising members: Name, address, DOB, business and home telephone numbers
- Authorized agent/designee: Name, address, business and home telephone numbers

B. Written Notification of Eligibility. The Ho-Chunk Nation Gaming Commission will provide a written notice of the organization's eligibility to conduct Class II bingo fundraisers.

C. Charitable Class II Gaming Event

Summary. Within 10 days of any fundraising event, the *Charitable Class II Gaming Event Summary* form must be completed and submitted to the Gaming Commission's office via mail, fax, email, or personal delivery.

SECOND: Request permission from the Bingo Hall Manager to schedule a Class II bingo fundraiser event.

A. Written Request and Justification.

Organizations wishing to conduct charitable bingo fundraisers on the Nation's lands are required to provide the Bingo Hall Manager with a written request and justification for the fundraiser.

B. Schedule Event. Approval and scheduling of the requested fundraiser event will be at management's discretion.
