COVID-19 Disease Prevention

Policy

To ensure the safety of our community supporting the Sacramento Rebels 38th Invitational Tournament, we developed protocols based on current community infection levels and prevention steps for Sacramento County.

Protocols

- Masks are required inside the gyms for all players, coaches, officials and spectators.
 1. Masks are optional for:
 - a. Players during their games while they are on the court and on the bench.
 - b. Coaches during their games.
 - c. Referees during their games.
- Self-screening for COVID-19 Disease symptoms is required for all players, coaches, officials and spectators.
 1. Before leaving your home/hotel to come to the gym, please self-screen. The self-screening questionnaire will be available online at www.SacRebels.org. Failure to disclose symptoms will result in the team being disqualified.
- Please use social distancing when eating and/or drinking.
- Between games, a Rebels representative will be sanitizing player/coaches seating areas, scorekeeper/timekeeper table, basketball, and other high touch areas.
- We are asking all attendees to sanitize their hands when entering the gym (hand sanitizer pumps will be available by main doors).
- Should any issues arise regarding non-compliance of protocols, a team may be disqualified from participating.
- If you test positive for COVID, please contact the Gym Coordinator for your division. A COVID test form will be provided for you to fill out. The form will help to communicate with those that have come in close contact.
- If a player(s) tests positive, we will ask that the rest of the team and coach(es) take a rapid/antigen test prior to their next game. Please have some antigen tests readily available if needed. Antigen tests will not be provided by the Rebels organization.
- As a result of any positive cases, brackets may or may not need to be adjusted. It will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the Executive Board.
