READ TOGETHER



READ John 14:1-14 in your Bible (Spark Story Bible page 448). Underline this KEY verse in your Bible: Jesus said, "In my father's house there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would i have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I prepare a place for you, I will also come."

#1: Family Altar: A place where you can gather things to connect with your family and to God. Add things like a cross, candle, a devotional book or Bible or other items that remind you God loves you!

#2: Build a Fort! Use your wildest imagination and create a BIG fort!

As we're thinking about the rooms in God's house, make different rooms in your fort to explore!

PRAY TOGETHER



Create a paperchain where everyone in your house writes one thing they are grateful for. Do this until Pentecost Sunday (May 31).

Help us share the Good News with others that Jesus is with them. We thank you this day for all the women who love us. We thank you for the world you made, which is our home, until someday we join you in heaven. Amen


Once the walls were dry, hopefully tomorrow afternoon, she could start unpacking and putting out all of her books and her stuffed animals and the stuff that made it seem like home.




God's House

Here's what I think my room in God's house will look like.


