From Pastor Lori's desk.

"If it is possible, as much as is in you, live peaceably with one another." Romans 12:18

A guru had a class of eager students seeking inner peace. He tells them about a man who came to him and said, "Teacher, I am so anxious. I'm desperate to find peace. I try to meditate every day but, I live over a 24 hour repair shop and the noise always distracts me." The teacher turns to his students and asks what they would tell the man. One student suggests he should be able to find peace in any chaos. One suggests he try quieting his mind by breathing deeper and relaxing. The teacher remained quiet till one student asks him what he had suggested. The guru just smiled and said, "I told him to move."

Thankfully, we don't have to move anywhere to find peace! We've found it right here on top of the hill in Dresser, WI. And, this year's theme is to celebrate our church as a Community of Peace, a growing gathering of peaceful people, and peace makers who follow Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace.

Biblical peace is both an internal, spiritual gift and an outward, active practice of living peaceably. Inner peace is the work of the Holy Spirit who reminds us that the basis of our calm is not the absence of trouble, a walk in nature or regular yoga classes. It comes from knowing that we have been reconciled with God through Christ's work on the cross. Trusting that the living God has adopted us as a precious son or daughter and sanctified us in Christ, we find a peace beyond understanding by believing that we will be found guiltless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

With our biggest problem behind us, inner peace is able to spill over into other aspects of our lives and become the foundation of living as a peaceful community. Jesus calls the church to be a calm, non anxious presence in a culture of fear, a beacon of faith and a safe place for all. In our pursuit of peace, we call upon Jesus and the Holy Spirit to help us as we actively pursue social justice, healthy relationships, humility, and compassion so that we can identify the walls that separate us, seek out common ground and work to mend the broken relationships and situations that could steal our joy and stifle our Christian service.

As we grow in love for God and one another - Blessings to you, O Community of Peace and, "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may about in hope." Romans 15:13

This is an exciting time for Peace Lutheran Church, as our reimagination is becoming our new reality! We are richly blessed by your generosity. By paying off the mortgage, we have entered a new era of ministry. Our staffing plan with two pastors has already allowed us to refocus on our mission of worship, service, and outreach. Our church is vibrant and thriving!

At our most recent Congregational Council meeting, we spent time reflecting on the importance of continued giving and the needs of our church moving forward. As we transition from a "mortgage-focused" budget to a "ministry-focused" budget, we want to share a few key points with you:

- **1. A Shift in Expenses** The blessing of making our final mortgage payment has made our new staffing model possible. While we no longer have a mortgage, we have essentially exchanged that financial commitment for another: investing in the leadership of two dedicated pastors. This helps us pursue the dreams God has placed before us. Our overall budget remains essentially the same.
- 2. Capital Campaign Commitments If you pledged to the Capital Campaign, please continue to fulfill your commitment. While the mortgage is behind us, our facilities still require care, including future needs such as furnaces and roof work. All gifts toward the facility are deposited into a designated account specifically for this purpose.
- 3. General Giving Matters Most We are striving to minimize requests for project-specific giving. Instead, our goal is to fund as much as possible through the general operating budget. When you give to the general fund, you directly support the daily work of our mission and ministry. The Council will then prioritize projects as resources allow, ensuring we remain faithful stewards of your generosity.

I thank the Lord daily that I am part of such an amazing family in Christ! Together, we look with hope toward the growth of our congregation and the continued reimagination of our ministries. With God's help, all things are possible.
