From Pastor Lori's Pen March, 2025

So, if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation; everything old has passed away. Everything has become new! 2 Corinthians 5:17

Greetings, Peace Lutheran! As your new pastor, and staff member I want to say thank you for the warm welcome, encouragement and guidance. It has been a delightful beginning to a new chapter in our collective service to the Lord.

The Christian life offers many opportunities to have fresh starts, too. Each week in worship, we begin with a time of confession. When we began our Lenten midweek series, Journey of Stones we took a few moments to assess the weight of our past mistakes. We imagined the stone in our hand containing our regrets. Even though it wasn't a pleasant experience, we realized that it is important to our spiritual growth to occasionally come clean with God, to admit that our lives are not perfect, that we do a few things we know shouldn't, and have failed to do a few things we should. The best part of the evening was that we were able to leave our stones of regret at the foot of the cross – with Jesus.

Thanks be to God, our confessions are followed by Good News. Psalm 103:12 reminds us that, "As far as the east is from the west, so far has the Lord removed our transgressions from us." What a gift! It is a gift to know that Jesus made it possible for the slate of our sin to be wiped clean. It is a gift to know that we can leave our regrets with Jesus and, allow him to make all things new. And it is a gift to know that with a clean heart, we can carry on without the weight of the past and begin again – a little wiser.

I do hope that you can join us for midweek suppers and services this year as we discover together what other stones we might be carrying. Let's remember that we don't have to wait for a Wednesday night, or a Sunday morning to have a fresh start with God. Lamentations 3:22 reminds us God's mercies are new every morning. Each sunrise is a reminder that as baptized children of God, we are becoming a new creation, claimed, redeemed, and set free by the love of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Each sunrise is an opportunity for a fresh start.

May the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

Stewardship Corner

"Good will come to him who is generous and lends freely, who conducts her affairs with justice...... She has scattered abroad her gifts to the poor; his righteousness endures forever." Psalm 112: 5 and 9, New International Version.

This Psalm is part of a group of five that combine praise with the sort of wisdom and counsel that is also found in the books of Proverbs and Ecclesiastes. It is quoted by Paul in his second letter to the church in Corinth as he encouraged them to continue and expand the generosity they had begun to practice. It echoes many other scripture passages that express the idea that acknowledging God's gifts and sharing them will result in the sort of blessings that will allow us to continue and expand our generosity. Chief among those gifts is the grace that God pours out on us through the suffering, death, and resurrection of our Savior, Jesus the Christ. As we celebrate in this season the wonder of the empty tomb, may we remember, as Paul reminded the Corinthians, "Now God, who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food, will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness." 2 Corinthians 9:10, NIV.

Little Dresses for Africa

On Feb. 1st we had 27 people attend our Sewing Day at Peace. In late April, Jeff & Vicky Simpkins will drive our dresses (and boys shorts) to the LDFA distribution center in Rockwood, MI. By then we will have about 500 dresses and 187 shorts ready! People continue to sew dresses at home, preparing to send them along with Peace's African trip next winter. Please pray for these little girls and boys.

Teach Haiti

Now that they are regularly back in school, our 6 children are thriving. The civil unrest in Haiti continues in surrounding areas. We hope to have pictures and updates soon on Rossendjy, Hervendz, Jean-Rubens, Soidenaica, Anne, and Nilandie. The ports and airports are closed to mail. The funds we send are safe, going to Wheaton, IL and then to the school.

Last year at Easter we sent extra money to buy chickens, and the children are eating eggs nearly every day. It is a great boost to their nutrition. Parents are required to help with the garden, animals, or school work each week. The students are also taught gardening and animal care as part of their lessons.






