Bylaw 6-2017

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE MAINTENANCE AND MANAGEMENT OF THE WATERWORK CONSERVATION

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as "**The Water Conservation Bylaw.**"

2. DEFINITIONS

- a) In this Bylaw "Municipality" means the Town of Norquay.
- b) "Water Consumer" or "customer" means the person responsible for the payment of accounts, charges or fees under this Bylaw.

3. WATER CONSERVATION

- a) All outside watering of lawns, flower beds, trees and gardens effective May 1st to September 30th of each year shall be permitted as follows:

Outside watering is permitted during the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 a.m. each day for a maximum amount of 2 hours.

- b) Any person who contravenes this section of the bylaw by watering outside of the hours stated in 3(a) shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of \$50.00 for the first offence, \$100.00 for the second offence and \$200.00 for the third offence and for each offence thereafter.

4. OTHER:

- a) No person shall convey, sell, dispose of or give away or permit water to be carried or taken away or use it or supply it for the use of benefit of others.
- b) The Municipality may by bylaw ration or limit the amount of water furnished to any and/or all consumers should circumstances warrant such action.

5. PENALTY:

- a) Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw or which no other penalty is provided shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon summary conviction to penalties provided under the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
