





Fire Hydrant flushing has begun. This will take about 3 weeks to complete in areas where fire hydrants are flushed, residents may notice a temporary discoloration of water and/or a temporary reduction in water pressure. The discoloration is not harmful and can be resolved by running cold water through a faucet until any sediment is flushed out
