TOWN OF NORQUAY
BYLAW NO. 276
BYLAW TO ESTABLISH STREETS AND ALLEYS IN TOWN TO BE USED FOR TRUCK TRAFFIC.

The Council of the Town of Norquay in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Reference To "trucks" in this bylaw shall be to all vehicles over the size of a light duty vehicle.
2. All trucks and busses entering the Town of Norquay are restricted to the following streets, alleys and avenues unless a permit has been issued by Town Council prior to entry.

Main Street from Highway No. 49 to North Railway Avenue.
The Alleys accessing the properties along Main Street on both the east and west sides of Main Street.

The East Road Allowance from Highway No. 49 to South Railway Avenue.

South Railway Avenue from the East Road Allowance to Main Street.

North Railway Avenue to the most easterly access to the CN Railway Elevator Access Road.

Full length of the CN Railway Elevator Access Road.
3. School Busses shall have access to these additional streets and avenues.

Second Avenue South from Main Street to First Street East.
First Street East from Second Avenue South to Highway 49 Road Allowance.

Highway 49 Road Allowance from First Street East to Main Street.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the general penalty bylaw of the Town of Norquay.
5. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the day it is approved by the Highway Traffic Board.
